## Statement on U.S. House Farm Bill's Repeal of the WOTUS Rule

(Washington, D.C., June 22, 2018) — The following statement may be attributed to James Edwards, Executive Director, <u>Conservatives for Property Rights</u>:

"The U.S. House deserves much credit. Its Farm Bill repeals the overbroad Waters of the United States rule's definition of 'navigable waters.' WOTUS repeal is imperative.

"The <u>Banks amendment</u> puts Congress, not unelected bureaucrats, in the driver's seat. This undoes the regulatory taking of private property. The WOTUS rule threatens landowners' property rights because of a suspect tie to interstate waters.

"The Senate now must send WOTUS repeal to the President."
