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Statement on Republican Study Committee 119th Congress Budget

This statement on the House Republican Study Committee's budget proposal may be attributed to James Edwards, executive director, Conservatives for Property Rights:

"The new Republican Study Committee budget document addresses several of Conservatives for Property Rights's priorities head-on. Most notably, RSC's budget kills the Death Tax, repeals Obama-Biden-era Waters of the United States regulatory takings of private property, and expands practical public benefits derived from the vast amount of federal land.

"The RSC budget imposes fiscal responsibility, reduces regulatory burdens, constraining federal agencies such as the EPA, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau and the Federal Trade Commission, while reducing radical ideological use of taxpayers' dollars. It pushes back some of the misbegotten Inflation Reduction Act's provisions.

"RSC provides certain protections for senior citizens, shoring up Medicare and Social Security's financial health while sheltering seniors in or near retirement from being dirty double-crossed. Though many of us conservatives wish it went further, including taking on more of the IRA and certain other bad policies, CPR applauds the RSC for proposing much good policy."

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
