Statement on Republican Study Committee FY25 Budget

This statement on the House Republican Study Committee’s fiscal year 2025 budget proposal may be attributed to James Edwards, Executive Director, Conservatives for Property Rights:

“The Republican Study Committee budget for FY25 contains many sound budgetary and fiscal measures while addressing several of Conservatives for Property Rights’s priorities.
